**Introduction:-**

World HIV/AIDS Day is observed every year on 1st December to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS, promote prevention strategies, and encourage supportive attitudes towards people living with HIV. To mark this important day, Third Year GNM students of INS & GHPSN organized a role play performance and poster exhibition, highlighting key messages on HIV transmission, prevention, stigma reduction, and care on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025.

**Objectives of the HIV/AIDS day celebration was to :-**

- Educate students and the community about HIV/AIDS.
- promote accurate knowledge on modes of transmission and prevention.
- Reduce stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV/AIDS.
- Encourage compassionate and supportive behaviour.
- Strengthen students' communication, creativity, and health education skills.

**Activitis:-**

**Role Play:-**

The TY GNM students performed an engaging and impactful 20–30 minute role play as a part of the World AIDS Day awareness program. The performance thoughtfully depicted real-life scenarios involving an individual diagnosed with HIV, allowing the audience to understand the emotional, social, and medical challenges faced by people living with the condition. Through the well-structured scenes, the students highlighted common myths and misconceptions about HIV transmission and effectively clarified the scientific facts, helping the community differentiate between fear and reality.

The role play strongly emphasized the importance of early HIV testing, counseling, and strict adherence to antiretroviral therapy (ART) for a healthy and long life. Another important component showcased in the act was the stigma and discrimination that individuals often face within their families, workplaces, and communities. By portraying these sensitive situations, the students encouraged the audience to adopt an empathetic and non-judgmental attitude toward people living with HIV.



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**Poster Exhibition :-**

Poster Exhibition was arranged by the students of TY DGNM of INS & GHPSN displaying creative and informative posters on topics :-Modes of HIV transmission,Prevention strategies,Antiretroviral therapy (ART), Stigma reduction, Role of nurses in HIV care, Global statistics on HIV/AIDS Students used charts, illustrations, slogans, symbols (red ribbon), and fact-base to communicate key health messages.

**Participants/Beneficiary :-**

23 Students of TYDGNM, 2 faculty members, 60 Villagers from Sarsa Village.


