On this occasion, the prestigious *Shrimati Harshitaben Pathak Cash Award* was also conferred upon the Best Outgoing Students of both GNM and B.Sc. Nursing programmes. Each awardee received a cash prize of ₹10,000, generously supported by Mr. & Mrs. Pathak, as a mark of encouragement and appreciation for their dedication and excellence. Additionally, Certificates of Achievement were awarded to the first and second rank holders for the academic year 2024–25 as part of the programme.

We received 41 responses through the link.

The farewell program received an overall positive response. About 80% students rated the program as Excellent. while 17% rated it as Fair and only 5% as Poor. Regarding program organization, nearly 61% students were satisfied, 34% expressed a neutral opinion, and only 5% were dissatisfied. For the sound system and seating arrangement, around 90% respondents rated it from Good. Overall satisfaction levels were high, with approximately 63.5% students being satisfied, indicating that the farewell program was well organized and appreciated.

**Policy for awarding "Shrimati Harshitaben Maheshbhai Pathak Cash Prize" to the Best Outgoing Nursing Student of the Shri GH Patel School of Nursing, Karamsad**

The Cash Prize will be given to the best outgoing student of the Shri GH Patel School of Nursing, Karamsad. The Cash Prize aims to recognize and reward academic excellence, clinical competence, leadership ability, and contribution to the nursing profession.

1. The Cash Prize shall be called or named "Shrimati Harshitaben Maheshbhai Pathak Cash Prize".

2. **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for the Cash Prize, the student must meet the following criteria:

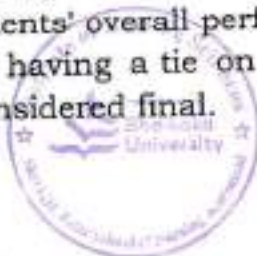
- 2.1 Must have successfully completed the Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery (DGNM) program in the first attempt during the course of study.
- 2.2 Must have exceptional academic performance with aggregate marks of the entire three years of training programme  $\geq 70\%$ .
- 2.3 Must have exhibited exemplary clinical skills, patient care, and professionalism throughout the program.
- 2.4 Must possess strong communication skills, interpersonal skills, active participation in professional development activities, extracurricular activities, and community service, and exhibited leadership roles in various curricular and co-curricular activities.

3. **Selection Process**

The selection process for the best outgoing student Cash Prize for DGNM will be as follows:

- 3.1 Programme coordinator will collaborate with course coordinators to identify eligible candidate based on the established criteria.
- 3.2 Selection committee, comprising the Principal, Programme coordinators and Course coordinators will review the candidates' and collectively determine the recipient of the Cash Prize based on the eligibility criteria. (As per clause 2 Above)
- 3.3 First criterion is 90% attendance in theory classes.
- 3.4 Second criterion is percentage or division of examination in the Gujarat Nursing Council examination, which should be  $\geq 70\%$ .
- 3.5 Final criterion is faculty feedback of the programme coordinator and class coordinators on students' overall performance.

If two students are having a tie on all above criteria, the decision of the Principal shall be considered final.



#### **4. Benefits:**

The Cash Prize to be given to the Best Outgoing DGNM Nursing student includes the following benefits:

- 4.1 A Cash Prize of Rs.10000/- will be given every academic year at the farewell programme of the institute or any other appropriate forum of the institute.
  - 4.2 A certificate of achievement recognizing the recipient as the Best Outgoing Student.
  - 4.3 Recognition through the official website and social media platforms as and when required.
  - 4.4 Display of name of such student on the prime locations of the institute.
5. The student should be awarded without any discrimination of religion, caste or community.
  6. The entire amount of this fund will be treated as a corpus and the interest earned thereon shall be utilized for expenses incurred towards the Cash Prize amount.
  7. In the event of no Cash Prize to be given in any academic year, the amount equivalent to the cost of the Cash Prize shall be added to the corpus fund.

#### **8. Review and Amendment:**

The policy will be reviewed periodically by the concerned committee of Shri GH Patel School of Nursing to ensure its relevance and effectiveness. The approval of the Board of Management, Bhaikaka University will be considered final for amendment in the policy.





## **Policy for awarding “Shrimati Harshitaben Maheshbhai Pathak Cash Award” to the Best Outgoing BSc. Nursing Student of the Institute of Nursing Sciences, Karamsad**

The award shall be given to the Best Outgoing BSc. Nursing student of the Institute of Nursing Sciences, Karamsad. The award aims to recognize and reward academic excellence, clinical competence, leadership ability, and behaviour.

1. The award shall be called or named as “*Shrimati Harshitaben Maheshbhai Pathak Cash Award*”

### **2. Eligibility Criteria:**

To be eligible to receive an award, the student must meet the following criteria -

- 2.1 Must have successfully completed the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) program in the first attempt during the entire course of study.
- 2.2 Must have exceptional academic performance with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) 7.5 and above.
- 2.3 Must have exhibited exemplary clinical skills, patient care, and professionalism throughout the program.
- 2.4 Must possess strong communication skills, and interpersonal skills, active participation in professional development activities, extracurricular activities, community service, and exhibited leadership roles in various curricular and co-curricular activities.

### **3. Selection Process:**

The selection process for the Best Outgoing BSc. Nursing student will be as follows -

- 3.1 Programme coordinator will collaborate with course coordinators to identify eligible candidates based on the established criteria.
- 3.2 Selection committee, comprising the Principal, Programme coordinator and Course coordinator will review the candidates and collectively determine the awardee based on the eligibility criteria. (As per clause 2)
- 3.3 First criterion is 90% attendance in theory classes in all subjects in each semester.
- 3.4 Second criterion is the academic grade of performance in the university examination, which should be 'Grade A or above' in each paper including theory (75% of marks and above).



- 3.5 Third criterion is feedback of the Programme Coordinator and Class Coordinator on students' overall performance.
- 3.6 If two students have a tie on all the above-mentioned criteria, The decision of the Principal will be considered final.

#### 4. Benefits:

The award to be given to the Best Outgoing B.Sc. Nursing student includes the following benefits:

- 4.1 An award of Rs.10000/- in cash will be given every academic year at the farewell programme or any other appropriate forum of the institute.
  - 4.2 A certificate of achievement recognizing the recipient as the Best Outgoing Student.
  - 4.3 Recognition through the official website and social media platforms as and when required.
  - 4.4 Display of name of the student on the prime locations of the institute.
5. The award shall be given without any discrimination of religion, caste, or community.
  6. The entire amount of this fund will be treated as corpus fund and the interest earned thereon shall be utilized for expenses incurred towards the award amount.
  7. In the event of no award to be given in any academic year, the amount equivalent to the cost of the award shall be added to the corpus fund.
